

DDAP Appendix B  
 HIV and Hepatitis C Services in Drug and Alcohol Treatment Facilities  
 The Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH) in partnership with the Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs (DDAP) recommends that clients of licensed drug and alcohol treatment facilities are informed of available HIV and viral hepatitis services.

Any entity providing LOCA must also provide:

Educational Services

- All clients seeking SUD services funded by the SCA must receive HIV and viral hepatitis educational materials.
  - DOH educational materials provided

Vaccination Services

- All clients seeking SUD services funded by the SCA must be offered:
  - Hepatitis A vaccination onsite or provided referral
    - Vaccine offered
      - Vaccine refused
      - Referral provided
      - Previous vaccination documented
  - Hepatitis B vaccination onsite or provided referral
    - Vaccine offered
    - Vaccine refused
    - Referral provided
    - Previous vaccination documented

Testing Services

CDC recommends that all adults be tested for HIV and hepatitis C. DOH and DDAP require all clients seeking SUD services funded by the SCA must be offered:

- HIV testing onsite or provided referral
  - HIV rapid test provided
  - HIV blood draw performed
    - HIV testing refused
    - HIV testing referral provided
    - HIV positive status documented
- Hepatitis C virus (HCV) testing onsite or provided referral
  - HCV rapid test provided
    - HCV blood draw performed
    - HCV testing refused
    - HCV testing referral provided
    - HCV positive status documented without subsequent treatment
- Hepatitis B testing onsite or provided referral
  - HBV blood draw performed
  - HBV testing refused
  - HBV testing referral provided
  - HBV positive status documented

All clients seeking SUD services funded by the SCA who are living with HIV, hepatitis B and/or C should receive treatment.
