

## ALTERNATIVES TO TRADITIONAL SENTENCING

### ARD Program

In some cases, first time DUI offenders may be eligible for Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition (ARD).

*Acceptance into the ARD Program is solely at the discretion of the Blair County District Attorney.*

#### Benefits include

- NO JAIL
- Expungement of criminal charge
- Limited license suspension

### Probation with Restrictive Conditions

First time DUI offenders who are not eligible or denied for ARD.

#### Benefits include

- LIMITED JAIL
- Fees for monitoring

## WORK RELEASE

You **must** contact the prison for work release information at least one week before you report to jail,

## \* REFUSALS

**Refusal** of blood, breath, test (all offenses) requires  
12 months license suspension  
18 months suspension for 2nd & subsequent offenses.

## 1st Offense

### BAC .08 - .099

0 days in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network  
\$185 Highway Safety Class  
\$300 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
6 months supervision  
No license suspension

### BAC .10 - .159/ Minors

2 days - 6 months in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network  
\$185 Highway Safety Class  
\$500 - \$5,000 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
6 months supervision  
License suspension: 12 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Immediately eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License (PennDOT form DL-9108).

### BAC .16 or higher/Refusals\*/Drug related

3 days - 6 months in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network  
\$185 Highway Safety Class  
\$1,000 - \$5,000 Fine  
\$300 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
6 months supervision  
License suspension: 12 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Immediately eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License (PennDOT form DL-9108).

## 2nd Offense (within 10 years)

### BAC .08 - .099

5 days - 6 months in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network

\$300 - \$2,500 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
6 months supervision  
License suspension: 12 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 6 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).

### BAC .10 - .159/ Minors

30 days - 6 months in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network  
\$185 Highway Safety Class  
\$750 - \$5,000 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
6 months supervision  
License suspension: 12 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 6 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).

### BAC .16 or higher/Refusals\*/Drug related

90 days - 5 years in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network  
\$185 Highway Safety Class  
\$1,500 - \$10,000 Fine  
\$300 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
Up to 5 years supervision  
License suspension: 18 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 9 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).

## 3rd Offense (within 10 years)

### BAC .08 - .099

10 days - 2 years in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network (CRN)  
\$500-\$5,000 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
Up to 2 years supervision  
License suspension: 12 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 6 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).

### BAC .10 - .159/ Minors

90 days - 5 years in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network (CRN)  
\$1500 - \$10,000 Fine  
\$100 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
Up to 5 years supervision  
License suspension: 18 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 9 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).

### BAC .16 or higher/Refusals\*/Drug Related

1 - 7 years in jail  
\$65 Court Reporting Network (CRN)  
\$2,500-\$15,000 Fine  
\$300 Demand Reduction Fund  
Community Service @ \$5/hour - hours varied  
Drug & alcohol assessment & treatment  
Up to 5 years supervision  
License suspension: 18 months  
Ignition Interlock: 12 months  
Eligible for Ignition Interlock Limited License after 9 months (PennDOT form DL-9108).
