Escatsy (MDMA)

- MDMA is an illegal drug that acts as both a stimulant and hallucinogen.
- Usually taken in pill, capsule, or tablet form
- Effects last approximately 3 to 6 hours.
- Produces extreme mood lift, increase in energy, pleasure, and social outgoingness, enhanced sensations (hearing, touch, and sight), and feelings of comfort and love are more apparent.
- Under the category of psychoactive drugs
- Also known as “Molly”
- Causes long-term health risks including
 - Harm to serotonin-producing neurons and to mood and cognition
 - Kills brain cells
 - Destroys neural pathways
 - Causes extreme dehydration
 - Increases body temperature to dangerous levels
