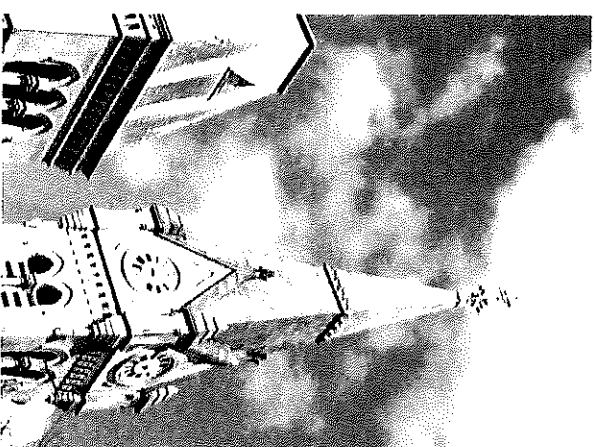

**MINORS DIVERSIONARY PROGRAM**

The Minors Diversionary Program is a 6-hour education course. The curriculum is designed to educate youth about the risks and consequences of alcohol and other drug use, assist in exploring alternatives, and developing good decision-making skills.

In addition to the above class, each youth is required to complete an in-depth drug and alcohol evaluation at **no additional cost**. If additional drug and alcohol treatment is recommended, cost is determined by ability to pay.

**REQUIREMENTS**

- *Attend Alcohol Awareness class*
- *Complete a drug and alcohol assessment*
- *Pay program fee*
- *90-day license suspension*
- *Pay Magisterial District Judge Court Costs & \$15.00 fee to the County of Blair*
- *Provide course completion to the Magisterial District Judge if attending a class outside Blair County*
- *Complete all program requirements within 90 days or the time period stated by the Magisterial District Judge*
