**Strengthening Families Program:** *7-week program for families and children between the ages of 10 and 14. Sessions on January 16-March 5, 2020 and April 23-June 4, 2020*

**Dual Recovery Anonymous – DRA** *is an independent 12-Step, self-help membership organization for people with a dual diagnosis. Meets Wednesday's at 6-7pm at BDAP*
