Presentation	<p>-COVID -19 update –BDAP/System-Judy Rosser</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -BDAP staff returned to office and are conducting all services via telehealth -Will be moving towards opening doors for face to face and community-based services on June 8, 2020 -Staff currently stationed in conference rooms to allow for social distancing; next week McCartney’s will be in to relocate the staff from the conference rooms and reorganize the offices to allow for the conference rooms to be opened for meetings -Conference rooms will be set up to allow for 6-foot distancing and are planning to be opened for internal meetings, committee meetings and groups on June 14th; Zoom meetings and conference calls will still be available for those asking to remain remote -Conference rooms will not be opened to external meetings -Masks and social distancing of 6 feet will still be required <p>-Presentation of the goals and objectives of the Drug Free Communities Grant</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Review of attachment Plan Year 2 – 12 Month Action Plan 2020-2021 -DFC grant is to be used to help build the coalition and the 12 Month Action Plan is a breakdown of how the grant will be used to help increase the community collaboration -The grant will allow the coalition to build a strong foundation and allow the community to have a clear view of what we are doing -Four town halls are to be held; request to have the Partnership members provide feedback on area or contacts to connect with for holding the town hall meetings -Enhancing skills by providing the best practices in prevention and what the coalition is doing in the community -Partnership Committees, including the Educational Committee, are integrating the DFC grant into their work; committees will be doing more and help develop more within the community -The building of the coalition will be measured by the baseline on what the partnership looks like and the rate that more people/organization are getting involved -Current work includes the sticker campaign, expanding the youth group in Hollidaysburg, promotion through social media and billboards -Reduce the number of students grade 6-12 who report that alcohol is easy to obtain by 10% by providing information, providing support, changing the consequences, reducing the access and changing policies <p>-Presentation of PAYS (Pennsylvania Youth Survey) – Postponed until June 25, 2020 Meeting</p>
