- **Blair County DUI Task Force/DUI Details:**

- Last roving; September 23rd – 84 contacts, 1 DUI arrest
- Grant for 2023 approved; started October 1st

- **DUI Dept. Updates:**

- **Monthly DUI Data:**

- .18 average BAC for Blair County
- Criminal Complaints - 25 - majority are higher BACs, refusals, and drugs
 - Higher alcohol content and binge drinking
- Lower BACs - 21 year olds; above 30 years is the problem
- 37 years old average age DUI
- Saturday/Sunday 12am-4am most arrests
- Mostly categorized as moderate to severe problem drinker
